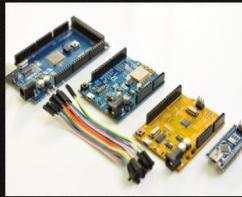

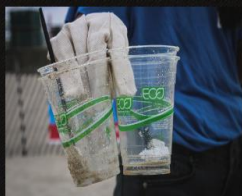

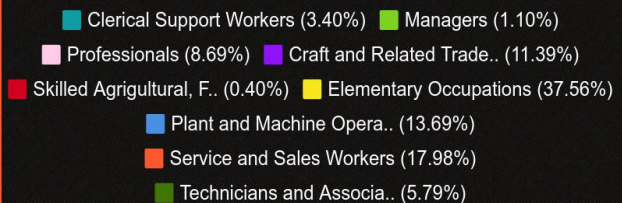
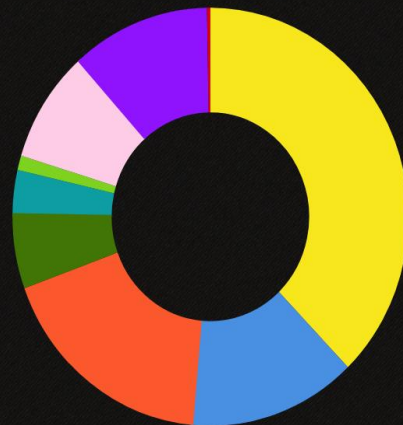
According to Philippine Statistics Authority, in 2018 the estimated number of Filipinos leaving to find work abroad was 2.3 million annually

According to Statistics Canada, Filipinos had a 73% employment rate, the highest of any immigrant group in Canada

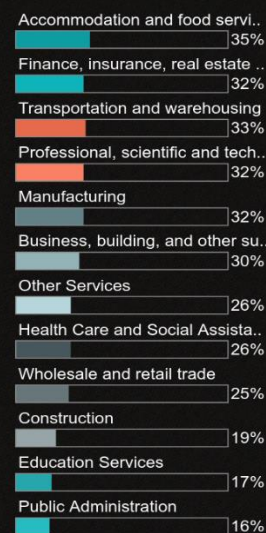


Low Unemployment
